T&R Graduate Certificate Requirements

Complete a concurrent (or have a previous) MA-FHS degree in our program. Required MA courses that meet certificate requirements are:

- HS 604 Advanced Individual Counseling
- HS 605 Advanced Group Counseling
- HS 610 Professional Ethics
- HS 620 Integrative Approaches to Dual Disorders
- HS 625 Addiction Recovery Services
- HS 641 Practicum II

In addition, complete two specific trauma courses:

- HS 601 Working with Trauma
- HS 602 Trauma and Recovery Services

Complete a Trauma-Informed Practice assignment in Practicum II:

This assignment asks you to demonstrate an evidence-based trauma-informed approach to your addiction counseling fieldwork. The assignment does not require extra fieldwork hours.
