SB 19-20 #045

TITLE: Reallocation of Readership Program Funds

Originator(s): Speaker Surritt

SPONSOR: Guerrero/Christman Administration

STATUS: Allocations Committee – Pending

WHEREAS: The Washburn Student Government Association passes a line-item budget each year to allocate annual Student Activity Fee dollars, and

WHEREAS: The Collegiate Readership Program has been terminated and the funds, totaling \$5,000, WSGA allocated to it are now unallocated, and

WHEREAS: It is to the benefit of all Washburn University students that WSGA is transparent in how it allocates its funds, and

WHEREAS: The unallocated funds should be reallocated to a service that can further WSGA's motto of "Student Serving Students", and

WHEREAS: WSGA's current system for campus-wide elections is being phased-out of use.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE:

SECTION ONE: The Washburn Student Government Association shall allocate an amount not to exceed \$3,300 to Engage's a campus-wide elections system.

~~SECTION TWO: The Washburn Student Government Association shall allocate the remaining funds of \$1,700 to Engage's pathway platform.~~

SECTION FOUR: This bill shall come into effect immediately after passage.
