Presented annually to an on-campus student organization that exemplifies a commitment to the career development of its members, to engaging WU Career Services staff in assisting members with career development, and to assisting WU Career Services with events and promotion.

All campus student organizations are eligible. Winner will be selected by WU Career Services staff. The decision of WU Career Services staff will be final and not appealable.

All organizations will be invited to present a portfolio of evidence in support of its candidacy by March 31. Presentation of evidence is not required but may help call the staff's attention to the organization's career-related activities for the year.

The award will be presented at the SOAR Awards reception or the Greek Awards banquet at the discretion of WU Career Services.

The winning organization will demonstrate its commitment to careers through activities such as:

Volunteering at the WU Career & Graduate School Fair, the Spring Career Fair, and other activities sponsored by WU Career Services.

Attending workshops and programs sponsored by WU Career Services, such as career fairs, "Make the Career Fair Work for YOU," "Actv8 Your Career," Résumé Roadshow.

Encouraging members to have active and regularly-updated BodJobs accounts and to use them for seeking and applying for jobs, campus interviews, mock interviews.

Encouraging members to use in-person services at WU Career Services, such as résumé reviews, job search assistance, and mock interviews.

Encouraging members to use Optimal Résumé to create new résumés and for interview practice, Career Services review of documents and interviews, and to create individual professional websites for online portfolios.

Inviting Career Services personnel to speak and present at organization programs. Topics may range from basic overviews of Career Services to specific topics on career choices, job search, networking.

Setting up mock interviews, networking events (practice or real), or other career-related events for members with the assistance of WU Career Services.

Acting as ambassadors for WU Career Services at Union information tables and other events.

Assisting with marketing and advertising WU Career Services and its services and events.
