I. CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Farley called the meeting to order at 3:30 via Zoom.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

III. REMARKS

From the President

- President Farley discussed the projected higher education budget in Kansas
 which includes an increase over the current year's budget of 1.5 million dollars.
 The purpose of the funds has yet to be specified. This may come with the
 stipulation no tuition increase. Without an increase in tuition, the proposed five
 percent salary increase will not be feasible.
- There has been an elimination of sales tax for food and food ingredients / groceries; we are working to be unaffected by this statute.
- There has been a request from the House Education Committee for information regarding students, program costs, the most profitable programs, general operations, and other such details.
- There are changes to mask mandates across the U.S. regarding mask mandates for K-12 and businesses. There are no plans in Kansas or at WU for changing what we are doing. There is possibility for pushback; we will be working with the local health department for guidance.
- There is current and will be further construction on campus. Things are going
 well overall. In December, the board passed a 35-million-dollar project to update
 Henderson. We have also received a ten-million-dollar donation from a private
 donor, which is meant to be spent on a recital hall. There are other buildings on
 campus to be moved to West campus (by the Villages).
- Michelle White-Godinet, the new Equal Opportunity Director/Title IX Coordinator, was introduced.
- Luther Lee, the new Vice President of Administration and Treasurer, was introduced.
