

Annual Washburn University Outdoor Sculpture Competition

New and exciting opportunities exist for artists with the annual Washburn University Outdoor Sculpture Competition and Exhibition. A professional selection committee will choose up to seven sculptures to be displayed on the campus of Washburn University in Topeka, Kansas. Walking-tour brochures will be published and a virtual tour will be created at www.washburn.edu on the "Art on Campus" page.

Who: All sculptors 18 years of age and older.

What: Up to seven sculptures are chosen, with each piece receiving a \$1,500 honorarium.

When: The exhibition runs from August through July.

How to enter: Artists may submit up to five works. There is a non-refundable \$25 entry fee.
