

# Call for entries: 2018-2019 Washburn University Outdoor Sculpture Exhibition

New and exciting opportunities exist for artists with the 23rd annual Washburn University Outdoor Sculpture Competition and Exhibition. Professional selection committees will choose up to seven sculptures to be placed on the campus of Washburn University.

## Honorarium: \$1,500 per sculpture.

- Washburn will facilitate purchase of selected artwork without commission. The exhibition is coordinated by and funded through the Campus Beautification Committee.

## Specifications:

- The contest is open to sculptors at least 18 years of age.
- Artists may enter up to **five** works for consideration.
- All submitted work must be of sound design, free standing and suitable for outdoor public display without external support.
- Steel and concrete pedestals and ground mounts will be provided for each selected entry when required.
- Only finished works will be considered.
- A professional selection committee will choose up to five sculptures through the process of jury review.
- Jurors are not eligible to submit work.

## Entry procedure:

- Each entry must include a Windows compatible CD of digital images showing two or three views of the work.
- Digital images must be saved to the CD in JPG format, 300 DPI or higher and 12.8" wide x 8.8" high.
- The image file name and the title of the work must be the same.
- All CDs must be labeled with the artist's name.
- CDs will not be returned.

## Fee: \$25, non-refundable

- Please make checks payable to Washburn University, with Campus Beautification Committee in the memo.

## Deadline:

- Entry forms and CDs must be in the hands of the committee by midnight May 31, 2018. *(The postmark date is not a qualifier.)*

## Responsibilities & liabilities:

Successful entrants must sign a loan agreement provided by the university and including, but not limited to:

- Permit Washburn University to install the artwork.
- Agree artwork will remain on display for the duration of exhibition.
- Agree that, in the interest of public safety and community priority, the university has the right to remove damaged sculpture and will notify the artist as to a course of action.
- Photographs of artwork may be reproduced for educational purposes and it is understood artwork may be photographed by students and the public.

- Artists will be responsible for the delivery of the sculpture to and from Washburn University.
- Artists will be required to reclaim their work promptly at the end of the loan period.
- Washburn University will be solely responsible for all aspects of installation.
- Sculptures will be insured against property loss up to a maximum loss of \$5,000, subject to a deductible of \$500.
