

Call for entries: 2020-2021 Washburn University's 25th Outdoor Sculpture Exhibit

New and exciting opportunities exist for artists with the 25th annual Washburn University Outdoor Sculpture Competition and Exhibition. Professional selection committees will choose up to seven sculptures to be placed on the campus of Washburn University.

Honorarium: \$1,750 per sculpture.

A first place winner will receive a total \$2,500 award

- The exhibition is coordinated by and funded through the Campus Beautification Committee.

Specifications:

- The contest is open to sculptors at least 18 years of age.
- Artists may enter up to **five** works for consideration.
- All submitted work must be of sound design, free standing and suitable for outdoor public display without external support.
- Pedastals and ground mounts will be provided for each selected entry when required.
- Only finished works will be considered.
- A professional selection committee will choose up to seven sculptures through the process of jury review.
- Jurors are not eligible to submit work.

Entry procedure:

- Each entry must include images showing three views of the work with at least one image showing the entire sculpture including any pedestal or mounting system.
- Digital images must be saved JPG format, 300 DPI or higher and at least 8 X 10 inches in portrait or landscape orientation.
- The image file name and the title of the work must be the same.
- Preferred submission is by upload but images may be submitted on thumb drives or other digital media. Upload entries to: <http://bit.ly/WUOutdoorSculpture2020>

Fee: \$25, non-refundable

- Please make checks payable to Washburn University, with Campus Beautification Committee in the memo.

Deadline:

- Entry forms and images must be in the hands of the committee by midnight May 31, 2020. The postmark is not a qualifier.

Responsibilities & liabilities:

Successful entrants must sign a loan agreement provided by the university and including, but not limited to:

- Permit Washburn University to install the artwork.
- Agree artwork will remain on display for the duration of exhibition.
- Agree that, in the interest of public safety and community priority, the university has the right to remove damaged sculpture and will notify the artist as to a course of action.
- Photographs of artwork may be reproduced for educational

and promotional purposes and it is understood artwork may be photographed by students and the public.

- Artists will be responsible for the delivery of the sculpture to and from Washburn University. Sculpture and all paperwork must be at Washburn University no later than August 1, 2020
- Artists will be required to reclaim their work promptly at the end of the loan period.
- Washburn will be solely responsible for all aspects of installation.
- Sculptures will be insured against property loss up to a maximum loss of \$5,000, subject to a deductible of \$500.
