Fall 2024 Enrollment Report Executive Summary

The Fall 2024 Enrollment Report provides an overview of student enrollment at Washburn University and Washburn Institute of Technology (Washburn Tech) originating from the 20th day census snapshot.

Table 1 contains the combined, duplicated headcount, credit hour, full-time equivalent (FTE) comparisons and summary demographic data between Fall 2023 and Fall 2024 for Washburn University and Washburn Tech.

Tables 2 and 3 contain headcount, credit hour, FTE comparisons and summary demographic data between Fall 2023 and Fall 2024 for Washburn University and Washburn Tech, respectively. Tables 4 - 7, and Charts 1 - 3 provide longitudinal trends documenting headcount, credit hour and FTE changes for Washburn University only.

Figures 1 - 4 of this Executive Summary display the 10-year longitudinal trends in Washburn University and Washburn Tech's enrollment and FTE, and Washburn University's headcount including and excluding high school students and FTE.

Washburn University/Washburn Tech Headcount and FTE (Figures 1 - 4, pages 3 - 4)

- Washburn University/Washburn Tech Fall enrollment headcount and FTE and has increased for the past two consecutive Fall terms, see Figures 1 and 2.
- Washburn University Fall enrollment headcount (including and excluding high school students) and FTE has increased to above Fall 2020 levels.

Washburn University/Washburn Tech Enrollment Summary (Table 1, page 5)

- Headcount increased by 524 students (7.6%) from 6,850 in Fall 2023 to 7,374 in Fall 2024.
- Credit hours increased by 6,990 (9.0%) from 77,686 in Fall 2023 to 84,676 in Fall 2024.
- FTE increased by 464 (8.7%) from 5,305 in Fall 2023 to 5,769 in Fall 2024.

Washburn University Enrollment Summary (Table 2, page 6)

- Headcount increased by 370 students (6.5%) from 5,663 in Fall 2023 to 6,033 in Fall 2024.
- Credit hours increased by 5,289 (8.4%) from 62,88 in Fall 2023 to 68,177 in Fall 2024.
- FTE increased by 351 (8.1%) from 4,318 in Fall 2023 to 4,669 in Fall 2024.
- Degree-seeking student headcount increased from 4,820 in Fall 2023 to 5,263 in Fall 2024 (9.2%); non-degree seeking students decreased 8.7% during the same period.

Washburn Tech Enrollment Summary (Table 3, page 7)

- Washburn Tech total headcount enrollment increased by 154 students between Fall 2023 and Fall 2024, a 13.0% increase.
- Washburn Tech credit hour production increased by 1,701 credit hours, an 11.5% increase.
- Washburn Tech FTE increased by 11.4%, from 987 in Fall 2023 to 1,100 in Fall 2024.

Washburn University Headcount Enrollment Charts (page 8)

- First-Time Freshmen comprise the largest proportion of enrollment by student classification (19.8%) and the largest proportion of student types with a record headcount enrollment of 1,196.
- The gap in full-time to part-time students has narrowed then widened over the past five-year period.

Washburn University Headcount Enrollment and Student Credit Hours (Table 4, page 9)

- Full-time headcount increased 10.8% and part-time headcount decreased 2.8% in Fall 2024.
- The Fall 2023 and Fall 2024 increases of student credit hours were the largest in the ten-year trend (6.3% and 8.4%, respectively).

Washburn University Headcount by Gender (Table 5, page 10)

• The proportion of Female students has increased over a ten-year trend, from 59.4% of the total student population in Fall 2015 to 62.6% in Fall 2024.

Washburn University Headcount by Student Classification and Full-time/Part-time Status (Table 6, page 11)


- Freshmen and Seniors continue to comprise the largest percentage of full-time students in Fall 2024, at 33.5% and 18.7%, respectively.
- Seniors and Graduate students comprise the largest proportion of degree-seeking part-time students, with 14.5% and 12.9%, respectively.
- Overall, the ratio of full-time to part-time students by classification has remained reasonably consistent over a five-year period.


Washburn University Full-time Equivalent Enrollment by Student Classification (Table 7, page 12)


• FTE enrollment had been decreasing for two years over a five-year trend but rebounded from 4,394 in Fall 2020 to 4,669 in Fall 2024.

Washburn University Full-Time Student Persistence Rates and Retention Rates by Student Type (Table 8, page 13)

- The Full-Time, First-Time Freshmen headcount increased from 626 in Fall 2020 to a record high amount of 1,119 in Fall 2024. Transfer students increased from 333 in Fall 2020 to 411 in Fall 2024. In combination, the new student total increased 959 in Fall 2020 to 1,530 in Fall 2024.
- The persistence and retention rates for Full-Time, First-Time Freshman increased from Fall 2020 at 80.7% and 66.3%, respectively, to 85.6% and 68.0% for Fall 2023, respectively. Fall 2024 student persistence and retention will be reported in next year's Enrollment Report.










