All college-bound students and their parents should fill out the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

The FAFSA is available October 1.

Some financial aid is awarded on a first-come,
first-served basis. Apply early!





You can fill out the FAFSA on a computer, mobile device, or the myStudentAid mobile app.

Filling out the FAFSA is free. Never pay a company or service to process your FAFSA.





By completing the FAFSA, you are automatically applying for a Pell Grant (free money).

Don't let the FAFSA intimidate you, and don't assume that you won't be eligible for any aid.






2023 Recap

FAFSA CHECKLIST A list of what you need to fill out the FAFSA If an applicant is a dependent student, the following are needed for both student and parent(s). FSA ID to log in (do this first) Create logins at fsaid.ed.gov. **Social Security Number** (if you aren't a US citizen, your Alien Registration Number) **Driver's License Number** (if you have one) Federal Income Tax Return, W-2s, and other records of money earned The IRS Data Retrieval Tool can transfer your tax information into the FAFSA. If the "Link to IRS" button is available, click it. Bank statements (checking and savings) and records of investments (stocks, bonds, and real estate other than the home you live in) Information on untaxed income (e.g., child support) List of schools being considered If you have all the above items ready, it takes about an hour to complete the FAFSA online.

Attention Seniors!

The FAFSA is officially open which means it is time to submit a form. Any student, regardless of income, who wants to be considered for federal, state, and school financial aid programs should be submitting a FAFSA form. This includes grants, scholarships, work-study funds, and loans. Colleges and career schools use the FAFSA form to determine how much financial aid you're eligible to receive.

TRIO News and Impact: 2023 A Year in Review

Student Opportunities

COE continued its national Opportunity Matters Book Club for a third year. For 2023, COE selected "Finding Me: a Memoir" by TRIO Upward Bound alumna and award-winning actress Viola Davis. The 2023 book converted 43 TRIO programs and 672 students at its conclusion in August. Additionally, more than 200 TRIO alumni and TRIO professionals took part in virtual book club meetings across the U.S. and U.S. territories. COE hosted a national speaker series in conjunction with the book clubs, including 2020 National TRIO Achiever Award recipient Ashley Doukas, 2022-2023 Chair of COE's Board of Directors and TRIO alumnus, Joe Givens, and Viola Davis's sisters Dr. Deloris Davis Grant and Dianne Davis Wright.

In April, COE received a \$750,000 grant from the Federal Communications Commission to launch TRIO Gets Connected. Through this two-year effort, COE works with state outreach coordinators in the 24 least connected states to ensure that every adult-serving TRIO program has the resources to raise awareness and expand enrollment into the nation's Affordable Connectivity Program.


