Associate in Science - Addiction Counseling
Bachelor of Applied Science in Human Services:
Addiction Counseling Emphasis

Program eligibility

Students who have completed an Associate in Science degree in Addiction Counseling at DVC are eligible to earn the Bachelor of Applied Science in Human Services with an Addiction Counseling emphasis at Washburn University.

Overall Degree requirements

- a. Minimum of 124 semester hours of credit (60 semester hours must be from Washburn University or other four year college or university)
- b. Minimum of 84 graded hours
- c. Minimum of 45 hours of upper division work (Junior-Senior level courses)
- d. Minimum of 60 hours at a four-year college or university. Of the last 45 hours required to complete the bachelor's degree, at least 30 must be earned from Washburn University **OR** at least 90 of the total overall hours required to complete the degree must be earned from Washburn University.
- e. Cumulative gpa of at least 2.0
