- Must have a cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or higher and a minimum of 24 hours completed.
- Return an application to the School of Business office, HC114, by the deadline date for the semester in which you intend to study abroad. The summer and fall deadline is **April 1st**, the spring deadline is **December 1st**.
- If offered a scholarship, students must sign and return an acceptance form. They are also expected to write a thank-you letter to the donor and make a public presentation about their study abroad experience during International Week.
