

WU Professor Leaves Legacy of Leadership

Dale Marcoux was a business professor at Washburn University from 1939 to 1973 who bequeathed \$1.9 million to the university, designated specifically for School of Business Leadership scholarships. This fund reflects Professor Marcoux's commitment to students and will continue to provide scholarships for many years.

To be eligible to apply you must formally declare a Business major as well as:

- Incoming Freshmen: have an ACT score of 26 or higher and a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4-point scale.
- Sophomores through Super Seniors, including Transfer Students: have a cumulative college GPA of 3.25 or higher.
- Demonstrated Leadership Skills highlighted within a detailed essay showcasing skills learned through community, work, and/or student organizations.

Please submit the following information: 1) Application form (attached) and 2) Typed Essay

Helpful Tips for submitting a successful essay:

- Be specific with your examples.
- Titles are not as important as actual skills learned by participating in activities. Even bad experiences can be good learning experiences.
- High school activities are only appropriate in the freshmen year; after that we expect to see examples of how you are continuing to expand your skill set.

Exemplary Marcoux essays will also be considered for a **12-hour full tuition ride scholarship** made possible by the *James David Pollak Memorial Scholarship*. This extremely competitive award will be granted to one or two students (dependent on annual funding amounts) declared in a Business major. To be considered the essay must include examples from each facet of a student's involvement – 1) Community, 2) Work (both paid and/or volunteer), and 3) Student Organizations.
