BSN Curriculum Requirements

General Education requirements:

- English (EN 101 Introductory College Writing and EN 200 Intermediate College Writing) 6 hrs
- Math (MA 112 Contemporary College Math **OR** 116 College Algebra) 3 hrs
- Communication (CN 101 Intro to Communication, CN 150 Public Speaking, **OR** CN 351 Interpersonal Communication) 3 hrs
- Humanities - 2 different subject areas 6 hrs
- Social Science – 2 different subject areas 6 hrs
- Natural Science – 4-5 hrs – the School of Nursing requires additional prerequisite courses.
- Institutional Requirements – 6 hrs (Belonging & Inclusion and Scientific Literacy)
