Our role: To facilitate external funding to Washburn University for programs, projects, and related activities

We provide:

- Customized search and proposal development support
- Internal approval and submission to funding agency
- Award and compliance management

What is Pivot?

- Developed for research administration at universities for grant planning submissions
- Over 33,000 funding opportunities representing \$34 billion in potential funding from both public and private sponsors
- 3.3 million scholarly profiles (and growing): Profiles are harvested from university websites and may be searched, claimed, and edited to suit needs of researchers
- Pivot suggests funding based on Pivot profile



Funding Opportunities

Comprehensive source for connecting researchers to funding:

- Trusted source for 30 years
- Activity locations all over the world (89 countries)
- 11,500+ national and international sponsors
 - All categories of sponsors, public and private
 - Government agencies, foundations, corporations, and non-profit organizations



Funding Opportunities



- Funding for many purposes:
 - Grants, fellowships, capital improvements, travel, visiting professors, training, conferences, and more
- Opportunities are currently available with confirmed or anticipated deadlines for as much advanced notice as possible
- Once a deadline has passed on an opportunity that will not be offered again, the record is purged from the database
- Opportunities are manually reviewed by editors for creation of the best possible keyword matches

Things to explore:

- Claim your profile and initiate Advisor recommendations
- Search by keyword, sponsor, funding type, or deadline
- Track funding opportunities for future cycles
- Save and share searches
- Find collaborators at other institutions

Basic Profile

- Existing profiles of faculty members as found on university websites
- Content from over 70 ProQuest-proprietary databases mined for author publications back to 1990
- Education Resource Information Center (ERIC) data from 1990
- Indexed information found in publically available sites
- Editorial processes applied to content for validation and consistency

Expanded Profile

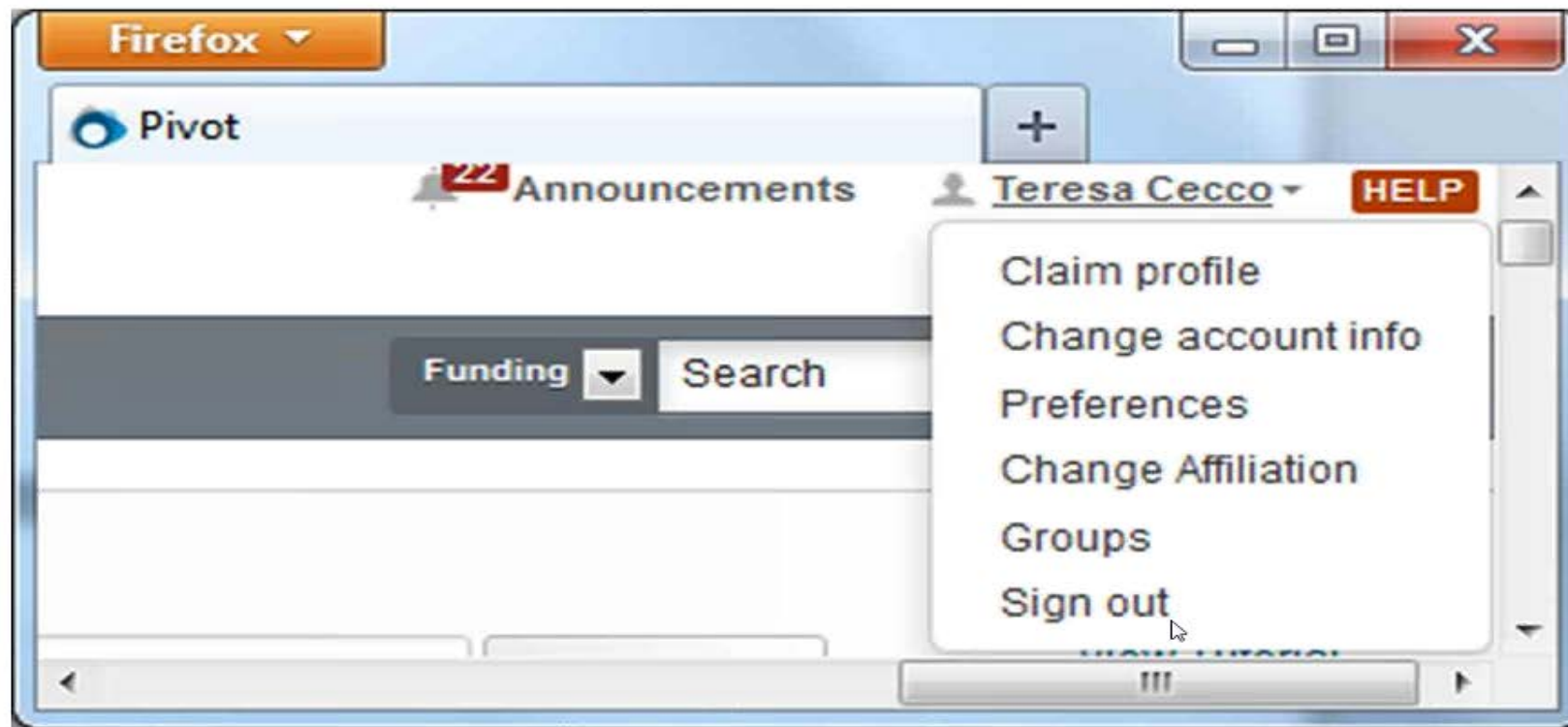
Claim your profile to add any of the following content:

- Contact information including e-mail address
- Up-to-date author affiliation
- Links to co-author profiles
- Verified publication list (not necessarily a complete list)
- Link to CV
- Link to personal web site
- Research Interests
- Additional information as available such as grants, associations, and honors

Effective Search Terms

- Pivot periodically adds new terms to fit emerging fields of interest, most recently in the sciences, social sciences, humanities, and the arts
- Examples of search terms include: Nosocomial Infections, STEM Education, Clean Technology, Carbon Sequestration, Organized Crime, Energy Industry, Synthetic Biology, Sustainable Design, Human Trafficking, Electronic Health Records, Green Buildings, Cloud Computing, and Urban Farming

Effective Search Terms

- Users can select keywords found on any funding opportunity in Pivot to create a search for opportunities by that term
