Eligibility

Current Washburn Art Students may enter up to four original works of art produced during the last 2 years and not previously accepted into the Student Exhibition. Eligible works of art must be completed at the time of entry. Dec 2023 & May 2024 grads are qualified to enter. **Students must meet all listed deadlines and requirements in order to participate.**

Juror – Rachel Epp Buller

Rachel Epp Buller is a visual and sound artist, art historian, professor, and mother of three. She holds a PhD in art history and an MFA in creative practice. Much of her artistic, written, and curatorial work has addressed the maternal body and feminist care in contemporary art contexts. Her current research addresses listening as an artistic method.

Rachel is a two-time Fulbright US Scholar (2010-11 to Germany and 2021-22 to Canada), a regional coordinator of The Feminist Art Project, a board member of the National Women's Caucus for Art, and Professor of Visual Arts and Design at Bethel College (KS/US).

Eligible Media

Each work of art may not weigh over 100 pounds or exceed 72 inches in any dimension. This includes diptychs, triptychs and any other multiple works considered to be one work of art.

Entry Format

Students may submit up to four entries in **JPG format only** to michael.allen2@washburn.edu. Please provide quality digital images of your artwork sized approximately 5 x 7 @ 300 dpi. Three-dimensional works may be represented with two views of each entry.

JPGs need to be labeled with: Artist Last Name, First Name; Title; Medium; Height x Width (in inches); Year; Name of Professor.

Notification of Acceptance

A list of the Juror's choices (accepted works) will be posted outside of the Art Department Office and the Mulvane Art Museum Office by **10:00 AM, Wednesday, October 16, 2024.**

Delivery of Accepted Work

All accepted work must be delivered to the Mulvane Art Museum on **Monday, November 18, or Tuesday, November 19, 2024, between the hours of 10:00 AM & 4:00 PM.**

The work must be complete, framed and ready to install (wired, hooks, etc...). Any work that has changed from the digital submission will not be accepted. Contact michael.allen2@washburn.edu or by phone at 785-670-2426 if you have special delivery or installation needs.

Conditions of Acceptance

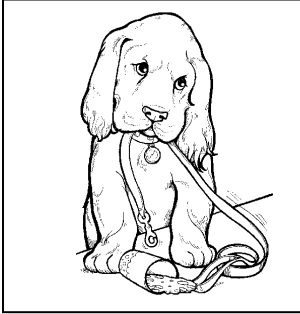

Works may not be removed from the exhibition prior to the closing date of **December 14, 2024.** Acceptance into the exhibition grants permission to the Mulvane Art Museum & Washburn University to reproduce work for publicity purposes only.

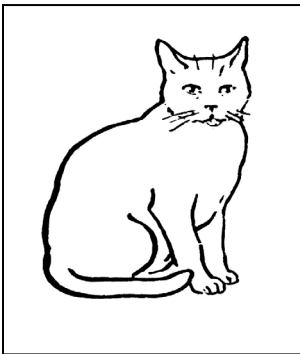
