Complete FAFSA

Complete the Free Student Application for Federal Financial Aid form: www.fafsa.ed.gov

- You may be eligible for other types of financial aid while receiving your Veterans Educational Benefits.
- You ARE NOT required to report federal educational benefits on the FAFSA, such as Montgomery GI Bill, Post 9/11 GI Bill, Dependent Educational Assistance, and Vocational Rehabilitation.

 - Discuss military transcripts and earning credit for military training/experience through DSST and CLEP exams which are funded for qualified military service members

- Copy of **Certificate of Eligibility** from Department of Veterans Affairs (this document is mailed to you once your VA benefits application is processed)

- Degree Plan (created with your Academic Advisor)
- Review and sign Benefit Utilization Memorandum of Understanding, keep a copy for your records.

Remember, certification for VA benefits must occur every semester that you are enrolled at Washburn University AND want to receive benefits.
