Must be enrolled in a minimum of twelve (12) undergraduate credit hours at Washburn University and maintain this minimum number of credit hours for the 2019-2020 academic school year. Must also maintain a cumulative and semester GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Excellent verbal/written communication and interpersonal skills; ability to work effectively and positively in a team environment; strong organizational skills; proficient computer skills, and Washburn Pride; ability to interact with people from various backgrounds.
