SENATE BILL <u>2024-25 #119</u> TITLE: The Food Flexibility Bill ORIGINATOR: Burdick/Wood Administration SPONSOR: Burdick/Wood Administration STATUS: Allocations Committee – Pending

WHEREAS: Food options for students through Chartwells Catering Services often come with significant costs, making it challenging to balance affordability and quality, and

WHEREAS: we are committed to supporting students and ensuring that events and meetings are accessible to all, and

WHEREAS: the current catering options offer limited accommodations for allergies and dietary restrictions, which restricts full participation for some students, and

WHEREAS: Chartwells Catering Services has come to an agreement with the Burdick/Wood Administration to increase food access for student organizations.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE WSGA SENATE:

SECTION ONE: The Washburn Student Government Association Senate hereby approves the document titled "Proposed WSGA Funding Policy – Chartwells Changes".

SECTION TWO: This legislation shall become effective upon January 1st, 2025 and bearing the signature of the WSGA President and Vice President.
