SB 20-21 #081

TITLE: Adequately Funding Campaigns

ORIGINATOR: Speaker Young

SPONSOR: Smith/Babcock Administration

STATUS: Internal Affairs Committee – Pending, Allocations Committee- Pending

WHEREAS: The Constitution and By-Laws are the governing documents of the Washburn Student Government Association, and

WHEREAS: The “Campaign Funding Policy” section of the By-Laws governs the WSGA election funding process and states how each campaign shall be funded, and

WHEREAS: Funding policy for each President and Vice President campaign pair are stated below:

A. Each candidate pair for the positions of President and Vice President will be allotted a maximum of \$200 from the WSGA budget for campaign materials.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION ONE: The WSGA Senate changes subsection 3.A of the Election Rules to read that “Each candidate pair for the positions of President and Vice President will be allotted a maximum of \$400 from the WSGA budget for campaign materials in accordance with the following rules:”

SECTION TWO: This legislation shall become effective immediately after passage.
